

Lesson Plan: Idioms

Expectations	The students will: <ul style="list-style-type: none">★ Practice writing by tracing letters★ Draw the literal meaning of the idiom★ Learn the figurative meaning of the idiom
Learning Environment	Small or large group setting
Resources / Materials	<ul style="list-style-type: none">★ Idiom Worksheet★ Crayons and/or markers★ Optional computer/projector
Content	Teaching students the figurative meaning of commonly used idioms in the English language as well as having fun with the literal meaning of the idiom will be the basis of the lesson. Showing the youtube clip https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=WVHIVbIgUH0 as preparation for the lesson would help build background.
Teaching Strategies	<ul style="list-style-type: none">★ Incorporate video clip★ Direct instruction★ Modeling
Closure	<ul style="list-style-type: none">★ Share drawings with each other★ Discuss other idioms they may know
Assessment	<ul style="list-style-type: none">★ Continue to do weekly idioms★ After doing 5-10 idioms, have them match the idiom
