Welcome back Mustangs! It is great to see everyone again, and I hope you had a great summer. Just a few notes of back to school business.

If your child has a chronic health condition, the health office needs to know about it so that we may be properly prepared. Paperwork was sent home this week with any student who has a chronic health condition on file with TSC. If your child received this paperwork please fill it out and return to school as soon as possible. If your child no longer has a chronic health condition and you received paperwork, please fill it out and send it back in stating this no longer applies. This includes anyone who may have a history of seizures, asthma, allergies, food allergies, or anything you feel the school should know about. We need new paperwork every school year even if your child's condition hasn't changed.

If your child requires an epi-pen for an allergy, or an inhaler for asthma, these need to be provided for the school to keep here in case of emergencies. Parents should bring any medications in to the health office. Do not send medications to school with students.
