# Wainwright Middle School

## Return to School

Thursday, August 20, 2020

School begins on-time, in-person, five days per week.  
TSC Virtual Academy option available.

## COVID Positive Protocol

May return to school when:

- Minimum 10 days after symptoms first present or two negative tests at least 24 hours apart AND
- Fever free for 72 hours without fever reducing medicine AND
- Other symptoms have ceased AND / OR
- Receive authorization to return from a medical provider.

## Cleaning Protocols

Additional cleaning and disinfecting products and equipment are on-site. Safe and effective cleaning products will be used regularly throughout the day at all high touch areas such as student desks. Additional custodian will be at school during the day to assist in cleaning and sanitizing. A building curfew of 6:00 pm s being put in place for all academic areas so regular cleaning can take place.

## Other Illnesses

Students must see a provider and be fever free for at least 72 hours without the use of fever-reducing medication prior to returning to school.

## Health & Safety Protocols



### If Sick - Stay Home

Families must screen their student before school each day. No one should enter school if they are not feeling well, have a fever, or have been in contact with anyone who is ill. Sick students at school will be directed immediately to the nurse, and a parent will be contacted.



### Physical Distancing

Physical distancing will be required in all settings where/if possible. Mask-wearing may be eased in settings where adequate social distancing is in place.



### Training

COVID-19 training will be provided for all teachers and staff on symptoms and screening measures.



### Masks

Social distancing is a challenge at Wainwright. Students and staff will be required to wear a mask the majority of the time. Staff will provide opportunities for students to remove their masks at appropriate times. Masks will not be required while eating. If your child is not able to wear a mask a majority of the day, please choose the TSC Virtual Academy option. Masks should be cleaned nightly.



### Divided Health Clinic Locations

There will be an area for students displaying COVID-19 symptoms who are waiting to be picked up and another area for medication distribution and routine health office visits.



### Hand Washing & Sanitizing

Routine hand washing procedures will be implemented and frequently practiced throughout the day. Hand sanitizer will be available in key common areas as well as in each classroom. Students are encouraged to bring their own hand sanitizer for personal use.

# School Environment Changes

- ★ All classes will have assigned seats for students immediately. Essential furniture and supplies will remain in classrooms. Students and staff will be required to wear a mask majority of the time in classroom settings.
- ★ A prepackaged breakfast will be available. Lunch choices will be limited and prepackaged. An additional lunch has been added to space students. Outdoor picnic tables have been purchased for lunch purposes to eat outside on good weather days.
- ★ Music classes will not perform (sing or play instrument at beginning of school year). Information will be given in class at the beginning of the year. Students will learn about their music course for the first part of the year prior to performing (more details to come)
- ★ Wellness classes will conduct activities outside as much as possible. Wellness will be on a rotating schedule. One day PE. One day Health. Students will be given a schedule to know which day is expected. PE activity will be limited to light activity. (ex.—walking, yoga, pilates, etc.) Locker rooms and uniforms will not be used for at least the first nine weeks.
- ★ Water bottles are encouraged for all students and may be filled using our bottle filling stations. Only the bottle filling portion of the drinking fountain will be functional. Be sure water bottles are cleaned nightly.
- ★ Parents, volunteers, & visitors will not be permitted until further notice. If students forget items at home, please do not bring these items to school.
- ★ Those arriving by bus in the morning will be released in such a way to avoid congestion. Dismissal will be staggered so all students are not exiting at the same time. 6th and 7th grade will arrive and exit door 1. 8th grade will arrive and exit to bus at door 15.
- ★ Sharing of supplies in all settings will be eliminated.
- ★ Additional picnic tables have been purchased to be placed in outdoor ed center, football pavilion area, and front of the building for teachers to take classes outside when applicable.
- ★ Students participating in TSC Virtual Academy will be allowed to participate in school sponsored extracurricular activities and athletics. Those students will also be required to follow the same guidelines (ie—code of conduct, grade checks, etc.)
